



## FY 2020 Annual Report to AABP Membership

### *Summary*

- Donations to the Foundation totaled \$80,422 in FY2020 versus \$17,850 in FY2019
- Unrestricted donations (including raffle ticket sales) for FY2020 totaled \$21,527 vs \$15,775 in FY2019 and \$11,138 in FY2018
- Total unrestricted assets for the Foundation as of 12/29/2020 are \$305,831 versus \$235,282 on 12/31/2019 representing an increase of \$70,549 over the 12-month period
- Since inception, the Foundation has funded 19 competitive research projects totaling \$423,127.39 in funding.
- The Foundation has funded 4 projects in collaboration with the Hoof Trimmer's Association (HTA). Total amount funded with the HTA is \$98,299
- The Amstutz Scholarship Fund (ASF) value totals \$1,277,335 as of 12/29/2020. Fund balance on 12/31/19 was \$1,107,241 representing an increase of \$170,094 over the 12-month period.
- ASF donations and auction proceeds in FY2020 were \$65,988 compared to \$119,673 in FY2019 and \$92,212 in FY2018.
- An online auction was conducted using the Give Smart platform for the 2020 conference. Auction proceeds totaled \$44,393, the lowest amount over the past six years.
- The Foundation awarded 37 scholarships at the annual conference totaling \$193,500 in student scholarship funding.
- The Francis Welcome Future Dairy Practitioner Scholarship fund had 70 individual donors making contributions totaling \$31,970.
- On Giving Tuesday, a total of 28 AABP members contributed \$5944 to the unrestricted fund, 1 member contributed \$670 to the Robertson Scholarship Fund, 5 members contributed \$5,305 to the Welcome Scholarship Fund, and 4 members contributed \$4,320 to the Amstutz Scholarship Fund in December for a monthly total of \$16,239 in the month of December!

Dairy Project – Dr. Gerard Cramer, University of Minnesota, “Development of a sole ulcer induction model in Holstein cows: The next step in lameness research” for \$24,990.00

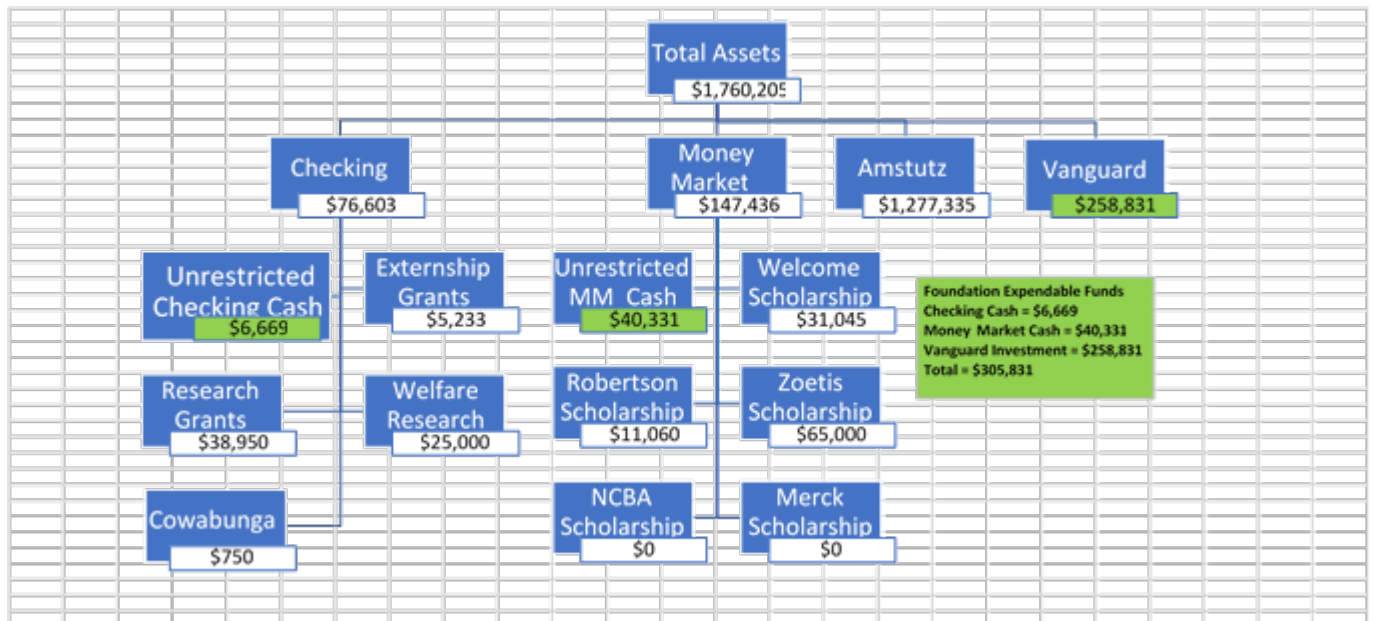

**Foundation Asset Breakdown**

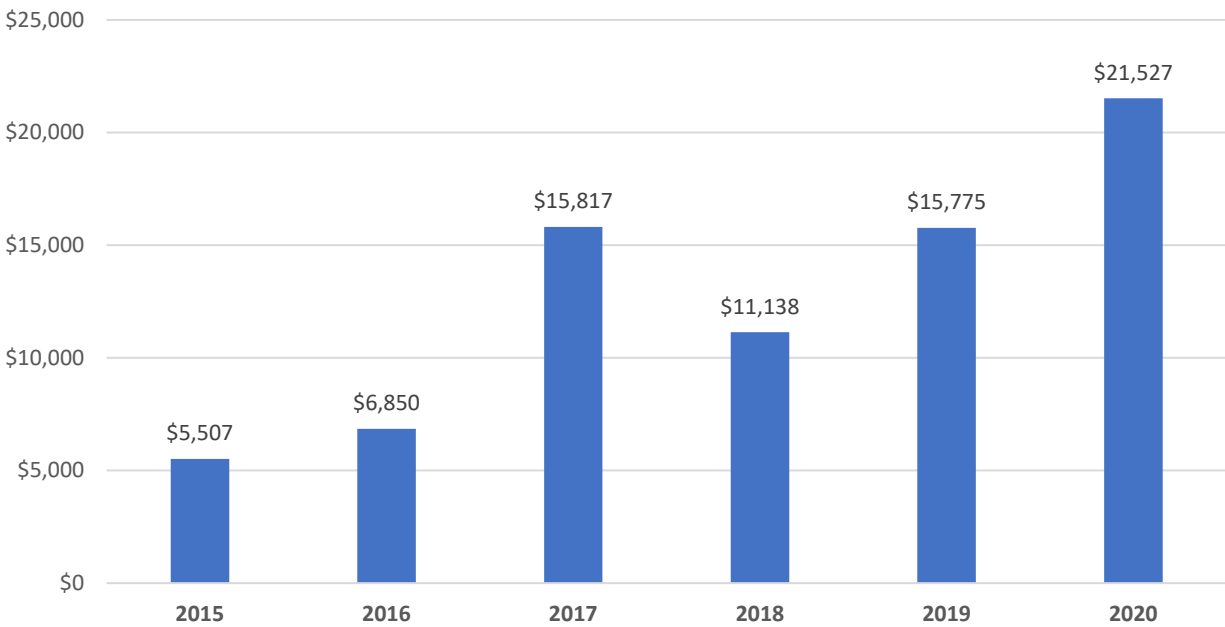

Total Foundation Assets = \$1,760,205

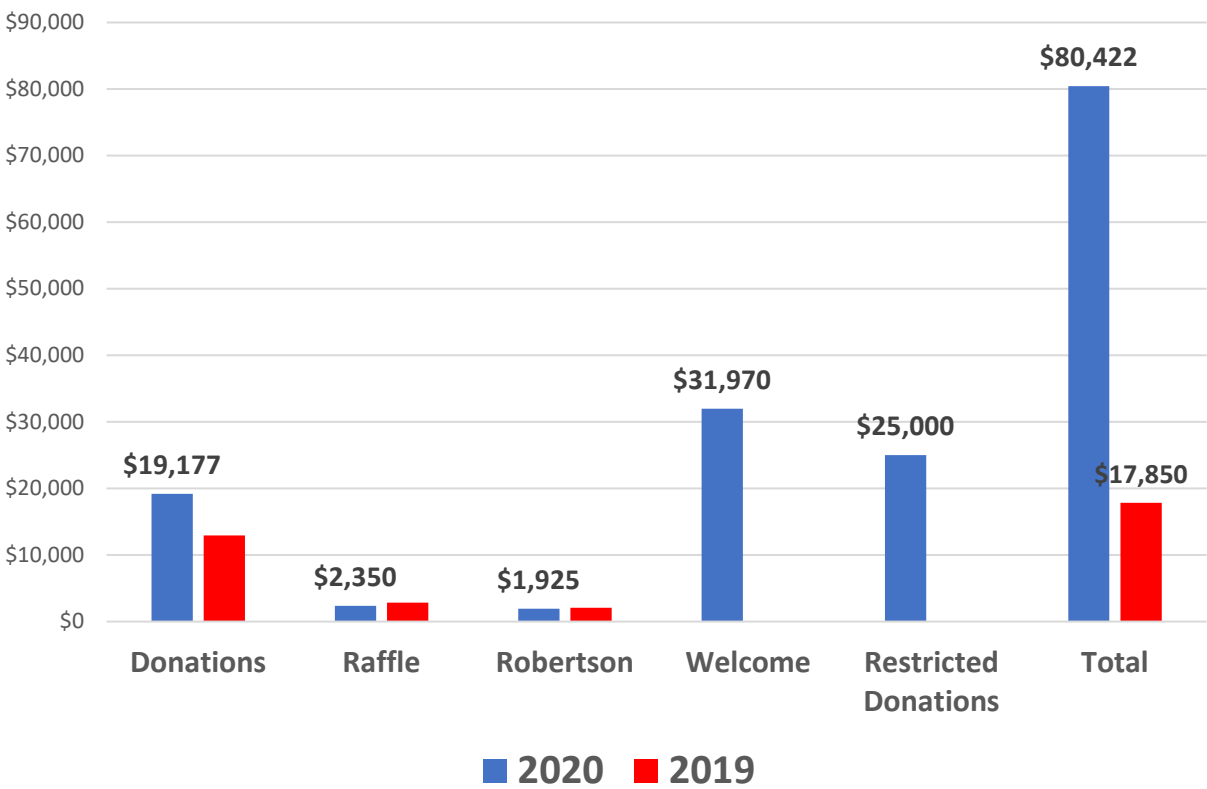
Total Unrestricted Assets = \$305,831 (cash and investment fund combined)

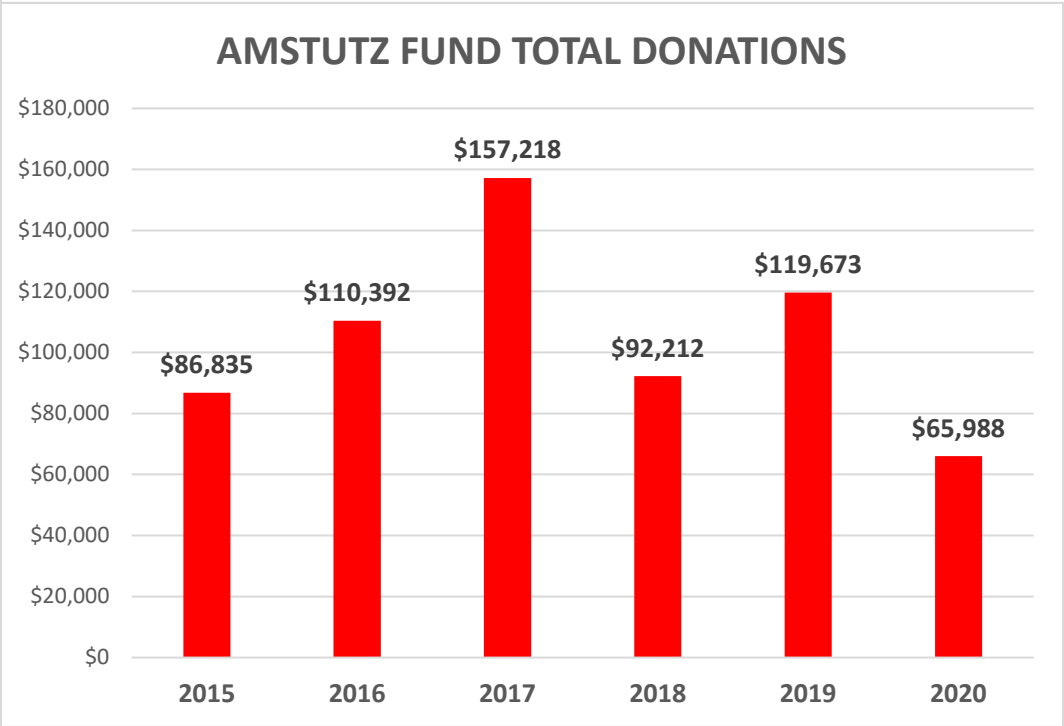
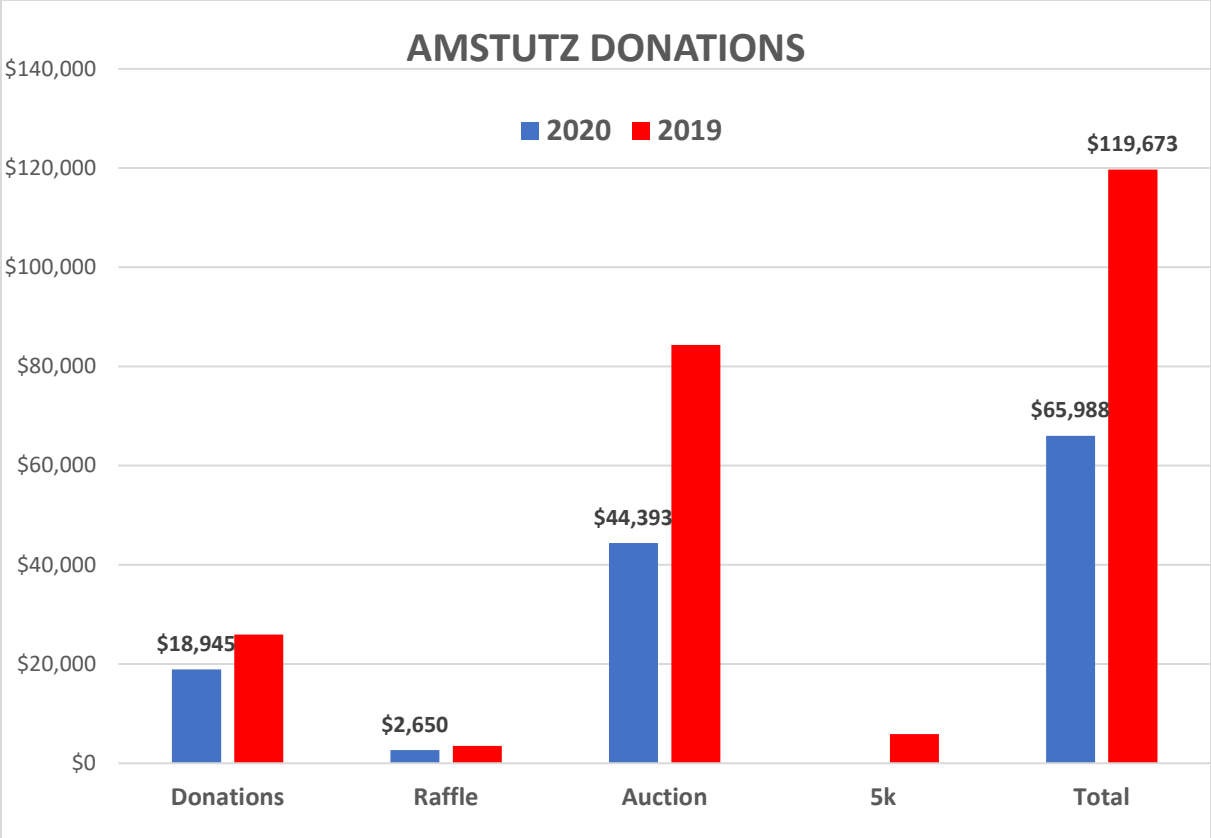


### Total Unrestricted Foundation Donations by Year
