Mission

The AABP Foundation supports advancements in the health, well-being and productivity of cattle through scholarship programs, educational opportunities, and applied clinical research that benefit present and future cattle veterinarians.

Summary of Distributions from the AABP Foundation for FY2025

- The AABP Foundation funds research grants, scholarships, externship grants and education grants.
- The AABP Foundation distributed the following grants for students:
 - \$20,000 in education grants to fund student educational programs
 - \$39,716 in externship grants to fund student externships at AABP member private practices
 - \$8,000 in externship grants for students enrolled at a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) funded by a donation from the BI Cares Foundation
 - \$10,000 in externship grants for students to extern at private practices located in Wisconsin funded by a donation from the Wisconsin Rural Opportunities Fund
 - **TOTAL STUDENT GRANTS = \$77,716**
- The AABP Foundation distributed the following scholarships:
 - \$115,000 for the Amstutz Scholarship recipients (11 students)
 - \$120,000 for the Zoetis Foundation Scholarship recipients (16 students)
 - \$90,000 for the Merck Animal Health Bovine Student Recognition award (9 students)
 - \$10,000 for the James H. Bias Scholarship recipients (2 students)
 - \$2,000 for the Edwin Robertson Scholarship recipients (2 students)
 - \$2,000 for the Francis Welcome Future Dairy Practitioner Scholarship (1 student)
 - \$2,000 for the Hunter Lang Dairy Welfare Scholarship (1 student)
 - **TOTAL SCHOLARSHIPS = \$341,000**
- The AABP Foundation awarded the following research grants:
 - Dr. Lisa Gamsjäger, North Carolina State University, “Does giving a single injection of a neonatal diarrhea vaccine to pregnant beef cows increase antibody transfer, calf health and growth?” - \$24,974.00
 - Dr. Celeste Morris, University of Missouri, “Evaluation of intrathecal lidocaine

hydrochloride euthanasia under intravenous anesthesia in cattle and resulting tissue residues” - \$24,971.83

- Dr. Matthias Wieland, Cornell University, “Bud-in or bud-out? A randomized field trial comparing two cautery disbudding techniques on wound healing in dairy calves” - \$15,041.00
- **TOTAL FUNDING DISTRIBUTED FOR RESEARCH GRANTS = \$64,986.83**

Total funds distributed in FY2025 by the AABP Foundation are \$483,702.83




Foundation Total Donations by Year


